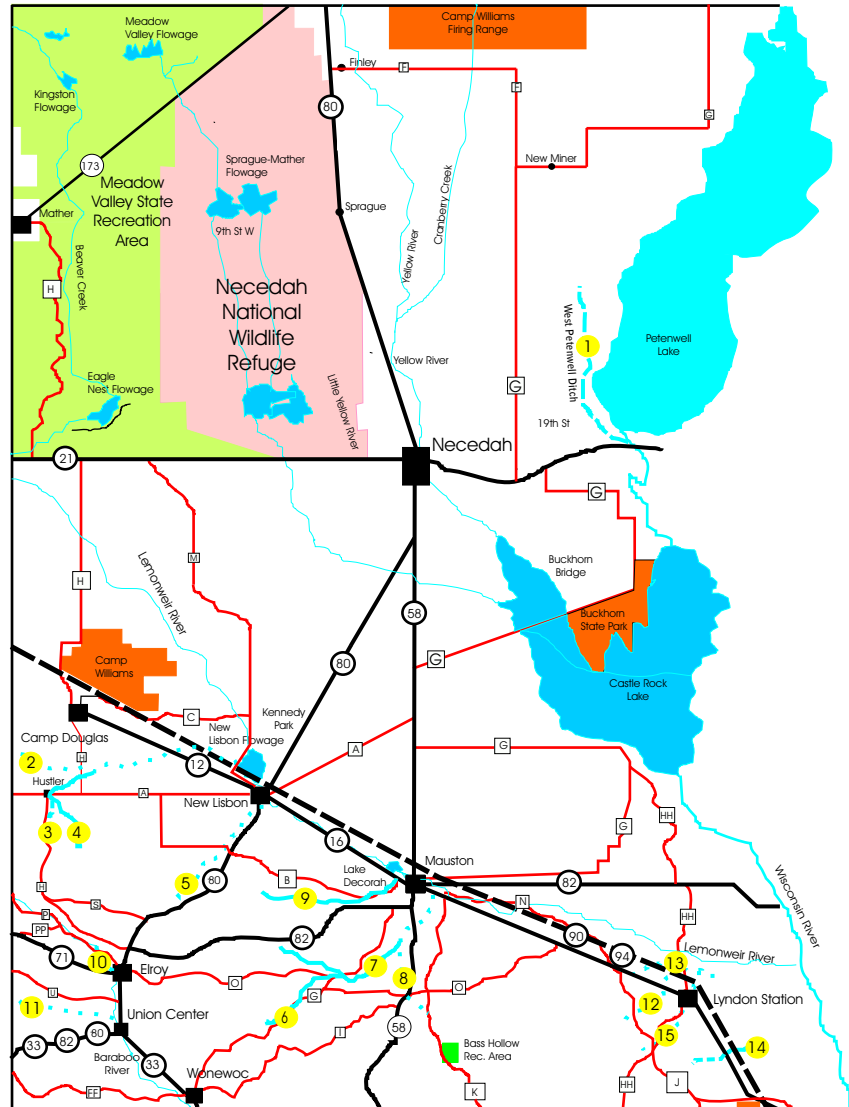
FYI, here's a brief description of those stream classifications.

**CLASS 1:** High quality trout waters with the capacity for natural reproduction and sustainable populations of fish.

**CLASS 2:** Some natural reproduction but require periodic stocking to maintain adequate levels of fish.

**Class 3:** Marginal trout habitat with no natural reproduction. Maintained by annual stocking programs.
