# Juneau County Economy Overview

Population - 26,624 (pop. grew 286 over last 5 yrs & projected to grow 281 over next 5 yrs)

Employment - 10,520 (jobs grew 301 over last 5 yrs & projected to grow 320 over next 5 yrs)

Labor Participation - ( increased over the last 5 years from 61.7% to 62.0%)

Median Household income - (\$48,900 for JC compared to \$57.7 Nationally)

Juneau County's unemployment has dropped steadily for the past 5 years and is at it lowest level in recent history at 3% or lower



# Juneau County Population Characteristics

Juneau County has slightly fewer Millennials per area than the national average


Juneau County has a significantly higher portion of workers retiring than the national average

Juneau County has a significantly higher population of veterans than the national average

Juneau County has almost  $\frac{1}{2}$  as much violent crime as the national average

Juneau County has about  $\frac{1}{2}$  as much property crime as the national average

Juneau County is extremely low in racial diversity



# Juneau County Industry Characteristics

JC number 1 jobs maker is Government, partly because of 2 prisons & National Guard AF Base. This is about 25% greater than the national average.

JC 2nd highest jobs maker is manufacturing which is 2/3rds higher than the national average. Manufacturing makes up approx 28% of our payroll.

JC 3rd highest jobs maker is Health Care & Social Assistance in which we are slightly under the national average

JC 4th highest job maker is Retail trade where we equal the national average

One area in which we exceed the national ave significantly, is in Ag, Forestry, Fishing & Hunting

JC is significantly below the national average in scientific, professional and technical services

1. Personal Care & Services ( JC has an aging population)
2. Food Preparation and Serving Related ( JC has a growing hospitality industry)
3. Transportation & Material Moving ( JC is on the interstate & has 3 class A Rail )
4. Construction & Extraction ( Extraction may be because of overlap from Frac Sand Operations)
5. Business & Financial Operations
6. Production ( JC has a growing manufacturing industry)
7. Installation, Maintenance & Repair ( this is an offshoot from manufacturing products)
