ORDINANCE NO. 21

An ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE ATV ROUTES

The Town Board of the Town of Armenia, Juneau County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1

ATV Routes Designated – Following all rules as provided in the Section 23.33 and all subsections of the Wisconsin State Statute – hereinafter designate the following streets to be designated as ATV Routes.

- 1. Only on 1st Street East – 4.8 miles from 22nd Avenue N. west to Finley town line.
- 2. Only on 2nd Street E. – 4.5 miles from 26th Avenue N. west to 20th Avenue N.
- 3. Only on 3rd Street E. – 3.4 miles from 20th Avenue N. east to the end of 3rd Street E., including 0.5 miles of Deerfield Drive.
- 4. Only on 4th Street – 0.45 miles from 24th Avenue N. west to 23rd Avenue N. and 3 miles from 22nd Avenue west to 17th Avenue.
- 5. Only on 6th Street E. – 0.55 miles from 23rd Avenue N. west to Porter Road.
- 6. Only on 7th Street E. – 3.6 miles from Porter Road west to 19th Avenue.
- 7. Only on 8th Street E. – 1.5 miles from County Highway G west to Finley town line.
- 8. Only on 9th Street E. – 4.91 miles from 19th Avenue west to Finley town line.
- 9. Only on 10th Street E. – 2 miles from 13th Avenue east to 17th Avenue.
- 10. Only on 12th Street E. – 1.75 miles from 13th Avenue east to 16th Avenue.
- 11. Only on 13th Street E. – 0.5 miles from 14th Avenue west to 13th Avenue.
- 12. Only on 16th Street E. – 1 mile from 16th Avenue west to 14th Avenue.
- 13. Only on 17th Street – 0.2 miles from 14th Avenue west to 13th Avenue.
- 14. Only on 13th Avenue – 5 miles from 8th Street south to 17th Street.
- 15. Only on 14th Avenue – 2.5 miles from 13th Street E. south to 17th Street.
- 16. Only on 16th Avenue – 3 miles from 12th Street E. south to Necedah town line.
- 17. Only on 17th Avenue – 6 miles from 4th Street south to 10th Street E.
- 18. Only on 19th Avenue – 2 miles from 7th Street E. south to 9th Street E.
- 19. Only on 20th Avenue N. – 2 miles from 2nd Street E. south to 4th Street E.
- 20. Only on 22nd Avenue N. – 5.25 miles from 1st Street E. south to 7th Street E.
- 21. Only on 23rd Avenue N. – 1.75 miles from 4th Street E. south to 6th Street E.
- 22. Only on 24th Avenue N. – 1.96 miles from 2nd Street E. south to 4th Street E.
- 23. Only on 26th Avenue N. – 0.75 miles from 2nd Street south to end of 26th Avenue.
- 24. Only on Porter Road – 1 mile from 6th Street E. south to 7th Street E.

New routes approved 2010 –

- 25. Only on 23rd Avenue from 2nd Street to 4th Street. (2miles)
- 26. Only on 4th Street from 22nd Avenue to 23rd Avenue. (2 miles)
- 27. Only on 20th Avenue from 7th Street south to end of 20th Avenue. (2+ miles)
- 28. Only on 9th Street from 19th Avenue to 20th Avenue. (1 mile)

Access Roads Only Approved 2010-

(To be used to travel to or from the main route only, not for continuous riding.)

29. Only on 5th Street from highway F to 17th Avenue. (1 mile)
30. Only on 6th Street from 17th Avenue to just short of Pine Lane.
31. Only on Big Bay Road.
32. Only on 23rd Terrace.
33. Only on Southview Drive.

Section 2

Other Rules That Apply To This Ordinance.

1. Must obey all laws and new laws that are set by the Department of Natural Resources.
2. At all times stay on the roadway single file on the furthest right portion of the road. No driving on any portions or rite of way at any time. Must stay on roadway.
3. All other licensed vehicles and pedestrians maintain to have the right of way.
4. No damaging of any part of any roadway or right of way while operating an ATV on any part of the designated route.
5. Operation of ATVs in the Township of Armenia only on designated routes. All laws for other operation are covered in 23.33 of the Wisconsin State Statutes and all subsections for off route operations.
6. All operators of ATVs on any part of the route must possess a valid driver's license.
7. All ATVs while in operation on the routes will have lights on at all times.
8. Each year on the nine day gun /deer season all ATV routes will be closed.
9. ATV operation on any designated snowmobile trails is forbidden in the Township of Armenia.
10. All access routes designated to get to the route is only to be used by the residents on that route to get to the closest designated route. There will be no cruising (back and forth) on any parts of the access route.
11. All access roads have a speed limit of 15 m.p.h. or less.
12. Operation of A.T.V.'s in the Township of Armenia shall not exceed 35 m.p.h.
13. ATV club will provide patrols and inspections of routes and will notify the Town Board of any possible hazards. The ATV club will also be responsible for the inspection of safety signs put up to designate the route.
14. Designated routes in the Township of Armenia are to be renewed on a year to year basis.

- In March of each year the ATV club is required to attend the regular town board meeting to request the ATV route renewal, and at that time requests can be made for any amendments or deletions to the designated route. Route is then renewed at the April regular town board meeting.

Section 3

Penalty – Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$250.00; together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof may be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding 90 days.

Section 4

Forfeited Penalties and Deposits – Except as otherwise provided in the Wisconsin Statutes and the deposit scheduled adopted by the state board of circuit judges thereunder, the forfeited penalties and deposits or bail not including costs or fees for violations of this ordinance, shall be equal to or less than the sum of \$250.00.

Section 5

Ordinance To Be Filed – The clerk shall file a copy of this ordinance upon its enactment and publication with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, with the constables of the town of Armenia, and with the sheriff of Juneau County.

Section 6

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
