Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Finley is required to adopt traffic regulations in strict conformity with state law and comply with ss. 349.06, and

Whereas the Town Board of the Town of Finley wants to better monitor the activity of ATV's, then

Be It Hereby Resolved, by the Town Board of Finley, that town ordinance No. 10 be adopted as follows:

TOWN OF FINLEY  
Ordinance No. 10

The Town Board of the Town of Finley, Juneau County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1

A.T.V. Routes Designated - Following all rules as provided in Section 23.33 and all subsections of the Wisconsin State Statute - hereinafter designate the following roads to be designated as A.T.V. Routes:

1. 7th Avenue
2. 2nd Street to 8th Avenue
3. down to 4th Street to 9th Avenue South to Sprague

Section 2

Other Rules That Apply to this Ordinance -

1. All A.T.V. operators on any part of the route must possess a valid drivers license.
2. Operators must obey all laws and new laws that are by the Department of Natural Resources.
3. Operators must at all times stay on the roadway single file unless safety deems it necessary to momentarily use any right of way for travel.
4. All other licensed vehicles and pedestrians maintain to have the rite of way.
5. No damaging of any part of any roadway or rite of way while operating an A.T.V. on any part of the designated route.
6. All A.T.V.'s while in operation on the routes will have lights on at all times.
7. Operation of A.T.V.'s in the Town of Finley is restricted to the designated routes. All laws

for other operation is covered in ss. 23.33 of Wisconsin State Statutes and all subsections for route operations.

8. All routes in the Town of Finley will be set at a maximum speed limit of 35 mph for ATV's unless otherwise posted.
9. Each year on the nine day gun/deer season, all A.T.V. routes will be closed.
10. A.T.V. operation on any designated snowmobile trails or routes is forbidden in the Town of Finley.
11. A.T.V. Club will be providing patrols and inspections of routes and will notify the Town Board of any possible hazards. Also will be responsible for the inspection of safety signs put up to designate the route.
12. Designated routes in the Town of Finley are to be renewed on a year to year basis:  
In March of each year, the Club is required to attend the Regular Town Board Meeting to request the A.T.V. route renewal and at that time requests can be made for any amendments or deletions to the designated route.  
Route is then renewed at the April Regular Town Board Meeting.

### Section 3

Penalty - Any person or persons who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00; together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof may be imprisoned in the County Jail not exceeding 90 days.

### Section 4

Forfeited Penalties and Deposits - Except as otherwise provided in the Wisconsin State Statutes and the deposit schedule adopted by the State Board of Circuit Judges thereunder, the forfeited penalties and deposits or bail not including costs or fees for violations of this ordinance, shall be equal to or less than the sum of \$250.00

### Section 5

Ordinance to be filed - the Clerk shall file a copy of this ordinance upon its enactment and publication with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and with the Sheriff of Juneau County.

Section 5

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
